SENATOR WESELY: I would just move the amendment, Mr. Speaker. Again, it reflects the committee amendments. It reduces the A bill by \$100,000.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Discussion? If not, those in favor of the adoption of the amendment, please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment as offered by Senator Wesely.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely, would you care to readvance the bill.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker, I move to readvance the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. Carried. The bill is readvanced. Anything for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do, thank you. I have a new resolution by Senator Wesely. (Read explanation of LR 425 as found on page 1886 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be laid over.

Senator Scofield would like to print amendments to LB 833; Senator Smith to LB 868; and Senator Morehead to LB 1232. (See pages 1886-89 of the Legislative Journal.)

That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Moving then to Item 6, General File and a special note on the time limit. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 675 is a bill on General File. It was introduced by Senator Chambers. (Read title.) The bill was introduced in January of last year, at that time referred to Judiciary, advanced to General File. The bill was considered on April 16 last year, Mr. President. On April 27th of last year there was amendments to the bill by Senator McFarland that prevailed. The bill was considered on March 10 of this year and that time Senator Hefner and Abboud moved to indefinitely postpone the bill. That motion is presently pending, Mr. President.
