CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Johnson.

CLERK: Mr. President, the...LB 518A first of all has Enrollment and Review amendments pending.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I move we adopt the E & R amendments to LB 518A.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Shall the E & R amendments be adopted to 518A? Those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Carried, they are adopted.
