LB 632, 1178

Mr. President, Senator Schmit would like to add his name to LB 632 as co-introducer; and explanation of vote from Senator Abboud. (See page 2034 of the Legislative Journal.)

That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Proceeding then to LB 1178, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1178, the first item I have are E & R amendments, Senator.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. Speaker, I move we adopt the E & R amendments to LB 1178.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The question is the adoption of the E & R amendments to 1178. Those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Carried. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit would move to indefinitely postpone the bill. The introducer would have the option to lay the bill over.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Schmit. Senator Conway.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, are there other amendments on the bill?

SPEAKER BARRETT: Yes, sir.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I have some deep concern about the bill, very frankly. I know that Senator Conway and Senator Ashford have worked long and hard on this bill and I would like permission to withdraw that kill motion at this time and let the amendments proceed.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. It's withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senators Conway and Chizek. (The Conway-Chizek amendment appears on page 2036 of the Legislative Journal.)
