LB 295A, 369

PRESIDENT: LB 295A fails with the emergency clause attached. Now we'll have the vote with 295A without the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Yes, we recognize you.

SENATOR MARSH: I would...

PRESIDENT: Yes, Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: ...sincerely request a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: All right, a roll call vote has been requested. Please check in. Just record your presence right now. Please look up to see if your light is illuminated and light it up, please. Senator Lamb. Senator Pirsch. Senator Landis. The roll call vote and the question is LB 295A without the emergency clause. Mr. Clerk. Please, just a moment. (Gavel.) Please return to your seats so we can have a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on page 2218 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on the passage of the bill.

PRESIDENT: LB 295A passes without the emergency clause. May I please introduce some guests. Senator Campbell and Senator Schmit have guests in the north balcony, Mayor Larry Marik of Columbus, Dale Collinsworth of the Chamber of Commerce in Columbus. Would you gentlemen please stand and be recognized. I misspoke, they are below the north balcony. Senator Arlene Nelson has 24 K-8 grade students and three teachers from District 4, Grand Island. They are in the north balcony. Would you folks please stand and be recognized. And thank you for visiting us today. We are on Final Reading which means that all bills upon prior to passage, prior to final vote are read by the Clerk. LB 369, please.

CLERK: (Read LB 369 on Final Reading.)
