ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have no E & R amendments. I do have a motion from Senator Wesely to indefinitely postpone the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker and members, 923 deals with asbestos regulation. This A bill reduces the appropriation to the Health Department. It's not an increase in appropriation so it wasn't felt that we actually needed the bill so this motion would kill the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any discussion? If not, those in favor of the adoption of the Wesely motion please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to indefinitely postpone the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The motion prevails and the bill is killed. To LB 1244, Mr. Clerk.
