PRESIDENT NICHOL: Thank you. Thank you, sir. Congratulations to you all. Will the committee please escort the Chief Justice from the Chamber. And thank you, Mr. Chief Justice. Moving on to the election of...the Chair recognizes Senator Lowell Johnson for the purpose of Section 9, the election of our permanent officers. Senator Lowell.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: Excuse me just a moment. (Gavel.) Let's have it a little quieter, please, so those that wish to hear can hear. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move that the following officers recommended by the Executive Board be approved for this Ninety-second Legislature. For Clerk of the Legislature, Patrick J. PRESIDENT NICHOL: Thank you. Is there any discussion? If not, the question is the election of these permanent officers. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 46 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of that motion.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: The motion is adopted and the members are elected. Move on to number 10, election of the Speaker. Senator Chizek, please.

SENATOR CHIZEK: Mr. President, I move to proceed to the election of the Speaker of the Legislature.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: All those in favor vote aye...all those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. We will move on to the election of the Speaker. The Chair will now entertain nominations for Speaker. Senator Baack, please.
