PRESIDENT NICHOL: You have heard the motion, all those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. It is passed and, Senator Lynch, you are the continuing Chairman of the Rules Committee. Enrollment and Review. Senator Abboud, please...Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Mr. President. Two years ago I had the opportunity to be elected by the members of this body to chair the prestigious Enrollment and Review Committee. It is with a great deal of regret that I leave that position but onward and upward we have to go. We have someone in our midst who I think would be an optimal choice for that position. He already starts well ahead of where I did, at least five rows, four rows. I think we would be well served by having Eric Will as Chairman of the E & R Committee and I would place his name in nomination.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: Very good, thank you. Any other nominations for Enrollment and Review? I have no other lights on. Senator Lindsay, would you like to continue?

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Mr. President. I would move that Eric Will be proclaimed E & R Chair by acclamation.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: You've heard the motion, all in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Congratulations, Senator Will. The Chair recognizes Senator Kristensen, please.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. I move that a committee of three be appointed to escort the Secretary of State to the Chamber to deliver the election returns of the General Election of November, 1990.

PRESIDENT NICHOL: Thank you. Senator Lamb, would you please serve on that? Excuse me, you have heard the motion, all in favor say aye. Opposed nay. So ordered and, Senator Lamb, would you serve on the committee to...with the Secretary of State. And, Senator Dierks, would you please serve on that, and Senator Crosby? Would you folks in the aisle please get out of the aisle so the Secretary of State...(gavel). Will you please clear the aisle so the Secretary of State can be escorted to the podium. Please clear the center aisle. Will the committee please escort the Secretary of State to the podium. (Gavel) Ladies and gentlemen, Mr. Allen Beermann, Secretary of State.
