Mr. President, Senator Schellpeper would like to withdraw LB 304. That will be laid over. Madam President, the next bill for consideration is LB 37. It was originally introduced by Senator Kristensen. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10. It was referred to the Judiciary Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending by the Judiciary Committee.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk, and I recognize Senator Chizek.

SENATOR CHIZEK: Madam President, I will address the committee amendment and then Senator Kristensen will address the bill. Basically, the committee amendments are found on page 412 of the Journal. And, originally, LB 37 had asked for a rate of 75 cents per page, per copy. As a result of a testimony at the public hearing, the committee felt that the rate of 50 cents per page, per bound certified copy, was a more reasonable figure. With that, I would ask and urge your adoption of the committee amendment.
