I think it is better that we have it very specifically in the law that it is an annual fee, and so this way it makes sure that it is an annual fee. If there is any questions, I would be glad to answer them.

SENATOR WARNER: Any questions? Any discussion? Seeing none, Senator Baack, do you wish to close? Senator Baack closes. The motion is the adoption of the amendment offered by Senator Baack. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The Clerk will record.

SENATOR WARNER: The motion is adopted. Is there anything further on the desk?

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Will. Oh, excuse me. Senator Wesely, you have your light on.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. President and members, on General File I raised the issue of the dealer plate issuance in the State of Nebraska, and this bill does tie into that dealing with trailers on boat dealers. It is really peripheral but it did raise the issue and Senator Beyer, Senator Emil Beyer and myself discussed this and I did have a meeting with the car dealers and the Motor Vehicle Department. And rather than pursue this issue further without hearing or without the adequate work that we need to do, we are going to introduce a study resolution to look at this issue of dealer plates and their issuance. If any of you are interested in dealer plates, and there is like 11,000 of them issued, questions about their fees and their utilization, I think all of those issues are legitimate. But rather than slow down this bill or take action further without having a public hearing, we are going to pursue that issue elsewhere. So I just wanted people to know and I appreciate Senator Baack's cooperation on this.
