Confirmation Report from Natural Resources, signed by Senator Johnson. Proposed rules change by Senator Beutler will be referred to Rules. Select File reports LB 36 to Select File with E & R; LB 124, LB 202, LB 47, LB 119, LB 171 all to Select File, some having E & R amendments. Natural Resources Committee reports LB 340 to General File; LB 341, General File; LB 402, as indefinitely postponed. Those signed by Senator Johnson. (See pages 604-06 of the Legislative Journal.)

Madam President, the next bill on General File is LB 128, a bill introduced by Senator Ashford. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10, referred to Urban Affairs, advanced to General File. I have committee amendments pending by the Urban Affairs Committee.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Madam President, members of the body, I think Senator Ashford...it deals with SIDs, which are probably mostly in Omaha and Sarpy County, there's a few around Lincoln. But what it does is simply says that when people are buying prospective homes they can have up-to-date information. What the committee amendment does, it simply states that for any late filing fee of a statement, a sanitary improvement district shall be assessed a late fee of \$10 per day, not to exceed a total of \$300 for each late filing. It clarifies that the...not the clerk him or herself has to pay the thing, it is the SID, and that there is...the max penalty is \$300, that's the committee amendments. I'd simply ask the body to support the committee amendments to LB 128.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Anyone wish to speak on the committee amendments? Seeing none, do you have a closing statement? Closing statement is waived and we will proceed to vote on the committee amendments to LB 128. All those in favor please vote aye, all those opposed please vote nay. Have you all voted on the motion to adopt the committee amendments? Record, Mr. Clerk.
