SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: (Mike not activated immediately.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber and with us this morning we have Pastor John "Mike" Loudon from the Eastridge Presbyterian Church here in Lincoln to lead us with prayer. Pastor Loudon.
