

February 12, 1991 LB 88

SPEAKER BAACK: The house is under call. All members please report to the Chamber, take your seats and record your presence, please. Call in votes will be accepted.

CLERK: Senator Moore voting yes. Senator Rod Johnson voting yes. Senator Will voting yes. Senator Beutler voting yes.

SPEAKER BAACK: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Debate has ceased. We will now proceed to Senator Kristensen. Do you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Mr. Speaker, I would yield my time in closing to Senator Ashford, if he chooses to make a....

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Just briefly, I appreciate Senator Kristensen helping on this amendment. Whether or not you like LB 88, this is a technical amendment which just conforms the LB 88 to provisions of current law to make them consistent and I would urge its advancement, its passage.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: I move we adjourn until 9:00 a.m., February 13th.

SPEAKER BAACK: We have a motion to adjourn. We also have a request for a board vote. All those in favor of adjourning vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 22 nays to cease debate or to adjourn, Mr. President, excuse me.

SPEAKER BAACK: The motion fails. We will now proceed to voting on the Kristensen amendment to LB 88. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Kristensen, et al's, amendment.
