PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. All members who are not excused please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Please check in. And we will accept call ins.

CLERK: Senator Nelson voting yes. Senator Labeledz voting yes. Senator Crosby voting no. Senator Rasmussen voting yes.
