

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. All members who are not excused please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel should leave the floor. Please check in. Looking for Senator Abboud, Senator Chambers, Senator Hillman, Senator Labeledz and Senator Lamb, Senator Lindsay, Senator Moore, Senators Peterson and Pirsch, Senator Schimek and Senator Schmit. Will the following senators please return to their seats, we are under call. Senator Lamb, Senator Abboud, Senator Lindsay, Senator Moore, Senator Labeledz. We are still looking for Senators Lindsay and Labeledz. Senator Schellpeper, Senator Lindsay is on his way. We'll proceed with the roll call vote on the motion to advance LB 45. (Gavel.)
