

February 22, 1991 LB 20, 259, 296

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 259 passes. LB 296E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 296 on Final Reading.)

(Recorder not activated immediately.)

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 773 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 296 passes with the emergency clause attached. I would now direct your attention to the south balcony of the Chamber. Special guests today of Senator Schellpeper are 22 government students from West Point Central Catholic High School with their instructor. Welcome to the Chamber today. Before we proceed with Final Reading again, I would please ask the senators to remain seated. Thank you. Now proceed with LB 20E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, LB 20E was considered by the body yesterday. At that time, Senator Wesely had moved to return LB 20 to strike the enacting clause. That's now pending.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Recognize Senator Coordsen. Oh, Senator Wesely, I'm sorry.

SENATOR WESELY: I'll withdraw that motion.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Motion is withdrawn. Proceed with Final Reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: In that case, Madam President, Senator Coordsen would move to return the bill to Select File for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President. Members of the body, the amendment that I am proposing to return LB 20E to Select File to attach is an amendment that came up in discussion as a result, I think, of Senator Wesely's amendment of yesterday morning. As everyone remembers, last year we enacted 931, which removed prohibitions against dual officeholding for everyone in the State of Nebraska, except for members of the Legislature and the constitutional officers of the state.
