PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. You have heard the motion to confirm the appointment of Larry Sitzman as Director of Agriculture. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to confirm? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the Agriculture Committee confirmation report.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The committee report is adopted. We will now proceed with Item 7 on the agenda, Final Reading. I will please ask the senators to return to their seats so that we can continue with Final Reading. (Mike off)...in their seats so we can proceed with Final Reading. LB 300.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 300 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 850 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 300 passes. Proceed with Item 8 on the agenda, with a motion. Do you have some items to read, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Madam President, Agriculture Committee whose Chair is Senator Rogers reports LB 583 to General File with amendments attached. That is signed by Senator Rogers. Hearing notice from Retirement Systems Committee offered by Senator Nelson as Chair. New A bills, LB 429A by Senator Rod Johnson and LB 142A by Senator Johnson. (Read titles to the bills for the first time. See page 851 of the Legislative Journal.)

Madam President, Senator Rasmussen would move to place LB 699 on General File notwithstanding the action of the Education Committee. Senator Rasmussen offered a motion on February 22. It is on page 789 of the Journal.
