SENATOR R. JOHNSON: No, I just move the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now proceed to vote on the amendment by Senator Rod Johnson. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Johnson's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Johnson's amendment is adopted. We'll now go to Senator Rod Johnson on the bill, as amended.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, I would simply move the bill as amended.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there anyone wishing to discuss the bill? Seeing no one, we will proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 716 as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of LB 716, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 716 is advanced. LB 493 has been removed from the agenda. We'll go to LB 190, introduced by Senator Schmit.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 190, introduced by Senator Schmit. (Read title.) Introduced on January 11, referred to Banking, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, LB 190 is a bill which I took for a small bank at Martell. And it would permit a bank that is located within an unincorporated city, or unincorporated area in a county, which contains a city of the primary class, that would be Lancaster County, to establish a detached auxiliary teller facility within the corporate limits of such city of the primary class, such as Lincoln. Two years ago, you will recall that we had a similar situation out in the Highlands area, and we introduced and passed a bill that allowed for that facility to establish a branch in the City of Lincoln.
