LB 205, 410, 498

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. All members who are not excused please return to the Chamber and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Please check in and we will accept call in votes. Looking for Senator Ashford, Senator Bernard-Stevens, Senator Morrissey, Senator Beyer and Senator Byars, Senator Robinson, Senator Hall, Senator Smith and Senator Hefner and Senator Lowell Johnson. We are accepting call in votes on the advancement of LB 410. Senator Cudaback, would you please check in too. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Why don't we just go ahead and do a roll call then.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Roll call vote has been requested.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 410 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 26 ayes, 13 nays on the vote to advance the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 410 advances. I would now like to call your attention to the south balcony.
