CLERK:    Mr. President, LR 53, by Senator Schmit, found on page 1064, congratulates the Wahoo Bishop Neumann boys' basketball team.

SPEAKER BAACK:    Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT:    Mr. President and members, as you know, Wahoo Bishop Neumann High School boys' basketball team won the Class C State High School Basketball Championship with a victory over Hartington Cedar Catholic. They won 21 of 25 games, and I think that in view of the fact, and I will talk a little bit more about this later on, that the Wahoo High School basketball team also was victorious in their efforts, the Wahoo girls' basketball team came to state, I think it recognizes a particular ability in the Wahoo area, in the area of sports. It shows tremendous spirit for the community, it shows a tremendous kind of cooperation that exists both in the parochial school and the public school, and I move for the adoption of LR 53 in recognition of outstanding achievement by the Wahoo Bishop Neumann High School boys' basketball team.

SPEAKER BAACK:    Thank you, Senator Schmit. Is there discussion? Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN:    I don't know whether to say this the first or the last, but it looks like there's an awful lot of discrimination going on here between two districts, between Senator Schmit and Robinson. If you notice, the next six have all to do with the districts. I can't understand how there can be that much concentration of basketball power in two districts, almost side-by-side. It doesn't seem right. I just wanted to call the attention of the body to that.

SPEAKER BAACK:    Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Any further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Schmit, did you wish to close? We will now proceed to vote on the adoption of LR 53. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:    26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 53.

SPEAKER BAACK:    LR 53 is adopted. We'll now go to LR 54, introduced by Senator Schmit.
