SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 330 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1098 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 41 ayes, 2 nays, 4 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 330 passes. We'll now go to LB 354E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 354 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 354 with the emergency clause attached be passed? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1099 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 26 ayes, 16 nays, 5 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 354 with the emergency clause...does not pass with the emergency clause. We will now proceed to vote on LB 354 without the emergency clause. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1099-1100 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 19 nays, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
