SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you. We will now proceed to legislative resolutions. LR 48 was introduced by Senator Rogers. My understanding is Senator Schellpeper is going to handle that.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 48 offered by Senator Rogers, found on page 986 of the Journal. (Read brief description.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Mr. Chairman and members, I am really honored this morning to present this resolution as a lifelong farmer. Agriculture is Nebraska's most important single industry and is the backbone of the state's economy. It's cultural heritage is founded on a strong rural background. The economic growth in manufacturing, retail sales and service industries in the state are dependent upon a healthy agricultural community. The National Agriculture Week and National Agriculture Day have been established to focus the national attention and appreciation on America's farmers and ranchers. Governor Nelson has proclaimed the week of March 17th through March 23rd, 1991 as State Agriculture Week throughout the state. This resolution declares that the Legislature also has March 17th through March 23rd as State Agriculture Week in Nebraska and March 20th, 1991 as State Agriculture Day in Nebraska. The Legislature urges all Nebraskans to honor and thank Nebraska's farmers and ranchers by supporting and participating in State Agriculture Week. There is going to be some bags like this presented to each one of you senators in your offices. It's all Nebraska grown products. They are all things that are grown off Nebraska farms and ranches. With that, I would like to just move the resolution. Thank you.
