

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, my amendment is one that I submitted, knowing that Senator Smith was dealing with the matter in a broader sense, but it has to do simply with one provision that allows for the charging of fees as deemed appropriate and I've always liked the standard tighter language that is generally used in the statutes which allows for the charging of reasonable fees not to exceed the actual costs thereof, the idea being to relate the fees to the cost rather than leaving it open and a little broader as to what the director may think to be appropriate. It's just a tightening down bit of...a bit of tightening down of the fee language, picking up language that we've used in other statutes for other agencies. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and I believe that I've explained the reasoning behind what I attempt to do in this amendment and so, with that, I would just ask the body to support the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there any discussion of the amendment? Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Smith? She waives closing. We will now proceed to vote on the amendment as offered by Senator Smith. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
