PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain today is Wendall Conover of Milford, Nebraska, who is Executive Director of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes of Nebraska.

WENDALL CONOVER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you Chaplain Conover. I now call to order the Sixty-First Day of the Ninety-Second Legislature, First Session. We will proceed with roll call. Please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The Journal is approved. Are there any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Madam President, one item. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 333 as correctly engrossed. That's signed by Senator Will as Chairman of Enrollment and Review. That's the only item I have. (See page 1657 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay, thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll proceed with Item 5 on the agenda, LR 69.

CLERK: Madam President, LR 69, offered by Senator Conway, found on page 1649 of the Journal, asks the Legislature to petition the Congress of the United States to appropriate funds necessary to adequately staff and equip veterans administration medical centers, to ensure quality health care for the veterans of this country.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President. LR 69 is a by-product of the Government Committee's interim study on the needs of the veterans in Nebraska, that we conducted last summer, across the state. While that study was primarily
