SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I move we adjourn until April 17th.

SPEAKER BAACK: Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President, a series of appointment letters from the Governor will be referred to reference; amendments to be printed to LB 409, to LB 91. (See pages 1673-74 of the Legislative Journal. Amendments to LB 678, LB 850 and LB 503 are also shown on pages 1674-77.) That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: A machine vote has been requested. I might make a brief announcement. It seems that a lot of people are not ready to take up their priority bills and since that is the only thing that is on the agenda right now, we're going to start working probably on some Speaker priority bills and committee priority bills on some of the days, so I would encourage my colleagues to be here and I do want to remind people, if they put friendly kills on the bills, those bills then are left in my hands as to when they are scheduled at that point. So we will now proceed to vote on the motion to adjourn until tomorrow morning at 9:00 a.m., and a machine vote has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? A roll call vote has been requested. We have a request for a call of the house. All those in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The house is under call. All members please report to the Chamber and record your presence, the house is under call. We need Senators Chambers, Kristensen, Schellpeper, Dierks and Beutler. We're looking for Senators Beutler, Chambers, Schellpeper and Dierks. We now need Senators Chambers and Schellpeper. Senator Moore said we should go ahead and proceed with the roll call. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.
