SPEAKER BAACK: Closing is waived. We will now proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 825A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. CLERK: 25 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 825A.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 825A advances. Before we continue on, I would like to introduce some guests of Senator Morrissey. They are from the China-USA Teacher Education Consortium and these are the delegates from China, and they are under the south balcony. Would you all please stand and be welcomed by the Legislature. Thank you for being with us. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do. Thank you. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 457 and recommend that same be placed on Select File with E & R amendments, LB 457A, LB 715, LB 715A, LB 186, LB 186A, LB 227, LB 701, and LB 852. And, Mr. President, your Committee on Revenue whose Chair is Senator Hall to whom was referred LB 829 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File. That is signed by Senator Hall as
