How can these people profess to be so moral and righteous in supporting this bill, be against giving the information, that they want in the bill, to the one who is affected? Senator Withem's amendment, Senator Labeledz, makes this information available to everybody, even those who cannot be pregnant. It goes to all of the students. It goes to the young boys. It goes to their parents. It goes to everybody. This, that we're talking about here, focuses on the young woman who is...

SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...pregnant. If we withdrew the Withem amendment all of the others, who would get that information under his amendment, will not get the information. The only one made aware of anything is the young woman who actually is pregnant. So the two do need to be in the law. And I, for the life of me, and I'm repeating it again, cannot understand how giving information can be wrong. It's almost like reverting to the days when Galileo was put on the rack and tortured because he said the earth moves. We should not, Senator Labeledz, put these young women on the rack of Galileo. We don't have to make ignorance orthodoxy, and we should not trick these young women. I support Senator Smith's amendment...
