SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us for the prayer this morning for Chaplain of the day, we have Pastor James Melang, from the All Saints Lutheran here in Lincoln. Pastor Melang.

SPEAKER BAACK: Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR MOORE: Speaker Baack and members, this weekend, the Milford Campus of the Southeast Community College will be celebrating its 50th anniversary. As those of you that have taken the time to read the resolution, obviously, you will remember that the Milford campus was the first vocational and technical college in Nebraska, was created by the leadership basically of one of my predecessors from the Seward area, State Senator Stanley Matzke. This campus has been recognized actually nationwide for work with the John Deere Company, work with General Motors Company, in a variety of things, and this resolution is simply commemorating their 50th anniversary. As I said, the celebration will occur this weekend in Milford. So with that, I would ask the body for the adoption of LR 68.
