

SENATOR MORRISSEY: To expedite things, I'd ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER BAACK: A call of the house has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, oppose vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.
