I guess if I get a deposition from someone or affidavit, I don't know, maybe get someone to stamp it for me that it has been approved by the people that approve it, the power companies, the compact, US Ecology that, yes, indeed that 2.5 million cubic feet you're suggesting to change now won't make the other states mad even though potentially they will be the host states sooner then because of that, because of potential increases in the future. Maybe if I could get a stamp of approval from them that that's okay, I would be more comfortable with it. Well, you folks haven't bought my argument that doing that will put us at risk...

PRESIDENT MOUL: One minute.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: ...even though it could be done admittedly other ways by other people that would not put us at risk. You wouldn't even gamble when the gamble is a sure...if I'm right, it's a big loss for the state. If Senator Johnson's right, it's no big deal. You wouldn't even gamble that way when it's a sure win or a sure loss in this case, I guess. If I'm right, it's a big time loss for the state and if I'm wrong, it's no big deal. You wouldn't even go for that. So I don't know why I think I can get any of these other amendments adopted like the one that treats everyone the same again like other boards and committees and strikes the Class II or Class III misdemeanor that if a board member or a committee member is convicted of that, they can be thrown off the committee. We don't treat other people that way, but yet we treat this monitoring committee that way, again, treating them differently, restricting their ability to operate.
