

to be debriefed by professionals, mental health professionals to deal with their concerns and overcome the trauma. This program has been in place. The problem that was brought to me was that the individuals in debriefing were concerned about potential liability in the process. This bill, essentially, sets up the program and then allows for them to do their job that they've been doing and not face any liability for that debriefing process that they work through. There really shouldn't be any problem with that. We had a lot of strong support from firefighters, police, other types of workers that face some very difficult duties across the State of Nebraska. This program is state wide. So I'd be happy to answer any questions, but I would like very much to have this amendment adopted.

**SPEAKER BAACK:** Discussion on the amendment offered by Senator Wesely? Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Wesely?

**SENATOR WESELY:** No, again, this would be LB 412, heard by the Legislature and advanced unanimously by the committee. Move for its adoption.

There were some problems as far as getting some of the different providers in the health...the health care providers put together on the amendment, so at that time LB 688 was amended to basically provide a moratorium on taking licenses away for a period of
