

should do and that there will be no discrimination for race, age, creed, national origin, sex or handicap. Someone may argue that it shouldn't be in here because there are other provisions of federal law perhaps or other things that independent institutions have to comply with. And that may be true, I don't know. But what I do believe, if we're going to move into this area, then there are some fundamental policies that ought to apply. And this is a fundamental policy that I think the agents, these institutions acting as agents for the institution and the awarding of scholarship ought to comply with, that is that there will not be discrimination for race, creed, age, national origin, sex or handicap in the awarding. And I would assume that the amendment would be adopted without opposition.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Madam President. I don't know if the amendment is necessary but it's certainly not objectionable. It does extend and clarifies or, I guess, it makes clear that the nondiscrimination questions do apply to these fundings and that is very clearly the intent of, I'm sure, the body that the nondiscriminations do occur. I would also urge adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. Is there anyone else who wishes to speak to this amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Warner? Closing is waived. Vote on the Warner amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.
