

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, if Senator Baack would yield to a question again.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Baack, I maybe didn't phrase my question because the area of Lincoln keeps coming up in here. And I do not want to get involved with the issue in Omaha. I'm trying to understand how the area that I probably represent is impacted. If there is someone who does not live in the Lincoln School District that has been paying tuition for students, what happens with your amendment, or what happens without your amendment, under those circumstances?

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Warner, that...the part that affects the Lincoln Public Schools is a different amendment in the bill than the Horgan amendment. There is an amendment in the...there is part...or a piece of the bill, of LB 207, that addresses the Lincoln situation. It's a different piece than what Senator Horgan is talking about.

SENATOR WARNER: So that's...I was getting confused here when I was asking, because I took it Senator Horgan said that Lincoln was affected by this amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Lincoln is affected by LB 207, but it's not affected by this specific...

SENATOR WARNER: ...but not by that amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: ...by this specific amendment, no, Lincoln...

SENATOR WARNER: That's what I had assumed was the case, but as I heard the conversation I wasn't clear.

SPEAKER BAACK: That would be the case.

SENATOR WARNER: Is there a...the Lincoln situation is in the bill as it is...how Lincoln is affected is in the bill as it already is, there is no amendment about to come up that changes that.
