ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Moore would move to suspend the rules in Rule 6, Section 7(b) to permit consideration of LBs 502, LB 647, LB 647A, LB 651, LB 652, LB 653, LB 760, LB 841, LB 842, LB 844, LB 847, LB 854, LB 854A, LB 855, LB 855A, LB 856, LB 856A, and LB 857 on Final Reading today. (See page 2560 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. Speaker and members, this rule suspension will allow us to read the remaining bills of the appropriation package that are shown on the agenda. These were bills that were passed on...I mean not pass...were advanced from Select File on Tuesday and Wednesday of last week, reported down from E & R on Thursday of last week, and so since they were reported on Thursday they have set aside our constitutional required one day layover before they can be read. The Legislature has a two-day rule. This would suspend that rule and allow us to read these bills and so then we can move forward tomorrow passing other A bills and so, with that, I'd simply ask for the rule suspension to allow us to read these bills.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the motion? Seeing none, we will vote on the motion to suspend the rules. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to suspend the rules.

SPEAKER BAACK: The motion prevails and we will now begin reading with LB 502E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 502E on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 502 with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2561 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, and 3 excused and not voting.
