ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 114 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 114 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2636-37 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 6 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 114 passes. We will now go to LB 114A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 114A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 114A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2637-38 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 42 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 114A passes. We are, for the present time, going to pass over 142 and 142A because they do have motions on them. If we have time at the end of the morning, we will take those up but we need to keep on doing Final Reading for right now. So we will go to LB 181E.

CLERK: (Read LB 181E on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 181 with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2638-39 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 6 nays, 1 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 181 with the emergency clause attached passes. We will now go to LB 181A.
