Senator Ashford, Senator Baack, Senator Landis, Senator Pirsch, Senator Haberman, please return to the Chamber. Senator Pirsch. House is under call. Members, please return to your seats, check in. Senator Pirsch. Senator Pirsch is on her way. Clerk will take roll call. The request is for roll call vote and in reverse order. Clerk will proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2720 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 11 nays.

SENATOR WARNER: Motion's carried and the bill is advanced. LB 614 (sic). Call is raised. LB 616.

CLERK: Senator Will, I have E & R amendments, Senator.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 616.
