SENATOR SCHROCK: Madam President and members of the Legislature, you've heard the arguments here. I wished I could have built a consensus from the senators involved. I did not spring this on them as a surprise. You've heard the arguments. Let's proceed with the vote.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schrock. We'll now vote on the Schrock amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Schrock amendment? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk. Yes, we have a request for call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and please check in. The senators please be seated and record their presence. The house is under call. Senator Hefner, Senator Schmit, please check in. Senator Rasmussen, Senator Rogers, Senator Wehrbein, Senator Haberman, please check in. We'll proceed with roll call vote on the Schrock amendment.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2729-30 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Need to verify.

CLERK: Madam President, I need to verify. (Verification of roll call vote.) 16 ayes, 12 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment fails. I will raise the call. Is there anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Conway would move to amend.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President and members. The amendment is which one, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: AM2186, Senator, is what I have.
