CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The house is under call. All members, please report to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Ashford, would you record your presence, please. Senator Nelson, record your presence. Senator Rasmussen, record your presence. Senator Dierks, please record your presence. We need Senator Rogers, Senator Moore, Senator Robak. We are looking for Senator Moore. All members are now present. We will do a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2750-51 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 11 nays to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The bill does not advance. Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Enrollment and Review reports LB 91, LB 91A, LB 615, LB 616, LB 617, LB 618, LB 619, LB 773, LB 783A, and LB 795 all reported correctly engrossed. I have amendments to be printed to LB 829. (See pages 2751-59 of the Legislative Journal.)
