CLERK: (Read LB 715A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 715A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2771 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 1 nay, 2 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 715A passes. We'll now go to LB 830.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 830 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 830 passes. Go to LB 830A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2773 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 29 ayes, 14 nays, 2 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting.
