CLERK: Senator, this one was filed on May 8.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Okay, this would be the amendment that I would like to withdraw at this time then.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Next amendment I have is by Senator Withem. Senator, your AM1719. (See AM1719 as found on page 2072 in the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, I'd like to take that up momentarily, if I could, just for purposes of visiting with the body.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, Mr. Speaker, members of the body, there seems to be some confusion on 719. 719, the guts of 719 were amended yesterday into 511. Our preference, Senator Lamb's and my preference would be to pull all of these amendments that are on 719, i.e., if you run your amendments and get an amendment adopted to delay an implementation date on a Lynch amendment, or to deal with hearing officers at Omaha Public Schools, or to deal with the Lincoln tier situation, or whatever else any of these amendments may deal with, when we get done with that whole process, there will be a motion by Senator Lamb to suspend the
