

and we will work on that. Probably on Tuesday we will do the rules changes. If the Rules Committee is ready at that point, probably on Tuesday we will do the adoption...the permanent rules changes. Wednesday we will only meet in the morning. We will adjourn at noon so that senators can attend the hearing on sexual harassment that will be held here at the Capitol and I would encourage everyone to go to that, at least spend as much time there as you can. Then the rest of the week we will simply be working on General File bills. The hearing schedule will be that we will start hearings of the committees on January 21. Right after the three-day weekend we will start hearings and those hearings will...we don't know how long they will continue yet. It depends on how many bills are introduced. So...and the last day for bill introduction, I think, is January 22. That's the tenth day and that will be the last day for bill introduction. And after we have the number of bills and we see how long the hearings are going to go, then I will set the dates for when the senators have to name their priority bills at that point. Some of you may want to name your priority bills early. If you do...a number of my colleagues have expressed that interest to me that they want to name their priority bills early and if they do that, those bills will come up in the next few weeks because we...I think that those take priority even over the carry-overs from last session if you have a personal priority bill for this session. So some of those will probably be named early. We may get into some pretty heavy issues right early on in the session. If you have any questions about that, you may ask me about it. With that, I move that we...oh, not yet, okay.
