SPEAKER BAACK: Or should we maybe advance it with the bill so that it is with it on Select File in case we do need it on Select File? I would suggest that, then the bill would be following it, if we don't need it on Select File, we can always kill it at that point.

SENATOR WESELY: All right. All right, that's fine.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the advancement of LB 678A? Senator Wesely, did you wish to close?

SENATOR WESELY: No, as I said, my commitment to Senator Robinson and Senator Bohlke is to try to find a way to do this without any funding and, hopefully, we won't need the A bill but you may be right so let's go ahead and advance it.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard Senator Wesely's closing on the advancement of LB 678A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 678A.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 678A is advanced. Introduction of new bills.

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read LBs 998-1006 by title for the first time. See pages 202-04 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, in addition to those items, amendments to be printed by Senator Lindsay and Wesely to LB 696. (AM2354 printed separately from the Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Dierks would like to add his name to LB 987, Senator Lindsay to LB 904, Senator Elmer to LB 872. That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Do you have any other messages, reports or announcements? Senator Hall, would you like to adjourn us until tomorrow morning at 10:00 a.m.
