PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for today is Pastor William Shaner, Regional Director of Development for the Martin Luther Home in Beatrice, in Senator Byars' district. Pastor Shaner.

PASTOR SHANER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Pastor Shaner. I now call to order the fifth day of the Ninety-Second Legislature, Second Session. We will proceed with roll call. Please record your presence.
