expensive, but in any case, it has been determined that administratively it could be around \$500. If anything, it's less. That is more than what generally a cost would be on an average. But the vehicle has to be in place to administer these Cash Funds in the adoption process. These costs already exist but they have to be provided for and the authority for that. I'd like to point out also that there may be some concern, I think Denny asked it, Denny Byars, about the need for hiring more vehicles and if, in fact, that could be additional costs and A bill responsibilities. This bill does not develop any additional adoptions in the state. The number of adoptions will not change at all because of this legislation and so I would simply suggest that we should not have to think about or consider or worry about the need for additional vehicles or staff, in my opinion. I would request your support for this A bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Lynch. Does anyone wish to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 823A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 823A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 823A is advanced. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Madam President. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 406, LB 406A and LB 543 to Select File with Enrollment and Review amendments attached, those signed by Senator Will as E & R Chair. (See pages 365-67 of the Legislative Journal.)

Judiciary Committee, whose Chair is Senator Chizek, to whom was referred LB 103, instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be indefinitely postponed, LB 295 indefinitely postponed as is LB 396, LB 438, LB 442, LB 620, LB 801 and LB 815, all indefinitely postponed.
