CLERK: Mr. President, LB 336 was a bill introduced by the Transportation Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 16 of 1991. At that time, it was referred to the Transportation Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File, Mr. President, with committee amendments attached. On March 4 of last year committee amendments were adopted by the body. There was an amendment to the bill by Senator Kristensen that was adopted. I do have amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Kristensen, would you like to open on the bill and just give us kind of an update of where we are before we proceed to any amendments?
