SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schimek, would you like to speak to the resolution.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you. Mr. Chairman and members of the body, I would simply like to add my note of congratulations to the young man who happens to be a son of a friend of mine, and also to the FFA organization, which I believe is an outstanding example of a well-run and well-organized FFA state chapter. SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Anyone else wishing to speak to the resolution? Seeing no one, Senator Warner, do you wish to close? Waives closing. We will now proceed to vote on the adoption of LR 226. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the adoption of LR 226, have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 226.

SPEAKER BAACK: LR 226 is adopted. We will go to LR 221.

CLERK: - LR 221, Mr. President, offered by Senator Kristensen. It is found on page 327. It asks the Legislature to approve a gift of land from the City of Red Cloud to the Game and Parks Commission to be utilized in the Indian Creek Wildlife Management Area.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the body, this resolution would grant permission through the Legislature for the Game and Parks Commission to acquire approximately 11.2 acres of land bordering the Republican River down in Webster County. This tract of land is a gift from the City of Red Cloud. And if it is approved by us, it then goes to the Governor. The State of Nebraska can accept gifts of land with the consent of a Governor, and that is what we are doing this morning is sending this to the Governor for their acceptance. This tract would be utilized as an addition to the Indian Creek Wildlife Management Area, which is already in existence, and the state does operate. This is merely a gift of land from the city to make that a little larger. There is no
