SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR LAMB: That is not...that is not the issue, but that's the way you get branded. So the people in here, probably including myself, I may vote for it because of that, because I'm not as hard-hearted as I'd like to think I am. But that's the problem. And so we're going to roll over, we're going to do what the federal government says, and we're going to go farther than that because they have threatened, they have threatened to take away atrazine. Let them take away atrazine, I don't care if they take away atrazine. I use a lot of atrazine, there are other herbicides we can use. Kansas is going to sue us because of the inflow of the Blue River. All right, we probably need to do some regulation, but I'm not at all sure we need this bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Lamb. I don't know if my position as presiding officer allows me to take confessionals, but we'll just let that go. Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk?
