

February 7, 1992 LB 877, 877A, 878

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 877 is advanced. LB 877A.

CLERK: 877A introduced by Senator Coordsen. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body, this bill without doubt is one of the most important pieces of legislation we'll be addressing this session of the Legislature. It eliminates an obsolete reference in Nebraska's employment law to a federal statute that has been repealed. I would encourage the advancement of this bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Does anyone wish to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 877A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 877A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 877A is advanced. LB 878.

CLERK: Madam President, 878 was a bill introduced by Senator Coordsen. (Read title.) Introduced on January 8, referred to Business and Labor, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body, if the top of my bald head is red it should justifiably be so. The previous bill was the A bill for the elevator inspection which was necessary because of the conversion from General Fund appropriations to a Cash Fund and it brought about \$60,000 that is necessary for the period of time to make that transition, is the bill that would eliminate an obsolete reference in Nebraska's statutes that refer to a federal law that has been repealed. I would encourage the advancement of 878.
