SENATOR WICKERSHAM: All right, thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Anyone else wishing to speak to the Beutler amendment? Seeing no one, Senator Beutler, did you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this amendment, to remind you once again, merely changes the language to narrow and to conform the bill to our narrower purpose which was simply to provide the entire mechanism for instituting an instream flow right. And so whatever you may think about the bill, I think this amendment will bring the bill more into conformance with the general view of the body of how that should be done. I would ask for the adoption of the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. You've heard the closing on the Beutler amendment. We will now vote on that amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the Beutler amendment. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
