SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: (Microphone not activated) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us for the prayer this morning we have Pastor Norman Pavey from the First Congregational Church in Fremont. Pastor Pavey.
