

February 13, 1992 LB 338A, 757, 758

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 834-35 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 757 passes. We'll now go to LB 758.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 758 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 758 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 835-36 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 758 passes. We will now proceed to the next item on the agenda, General File. We have a couple of A bills that need to be caught up with the other bills that have been moved ahead of them. So we'll go to LB 338A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 338A, it was introduced by Senator Rod Johnson. (Read title.) It was read for the first time on January 16th, placed directly on General File.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Rod Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members, this is a bill that creates a fund for water quality. And I believe Senator Moore had asked me on General File, as we were debating 338, since there is no specific funding earmarked in the bill, that he felt it was necessary for an A bill for this proposal and that is, in fact, what I am introducing here today, is the A bill for funding that particular program, if it should pass. I would move for advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on the A bill. Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Mr. President and members of the body, Senator Johnson, I have a question for you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Rod Johnson, would you respond, please.
